This includes but may not be limited to illegal, recreational or medically prescribed medications/drugs that impair a driver's ability to safely operate a vehicle on the trail (from beginning to end). CFW is a family friendly environment. All members shall conduct themselves in a respectable and orderly manner.

4WD vehicles intended for the purpose of off road use should be in good working order, with tow points at a minimum to be eligible for attendance on a CFW trail run. If you have any concerns, please coordinate with your Trail Leader.
